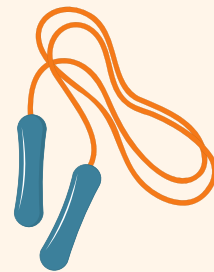

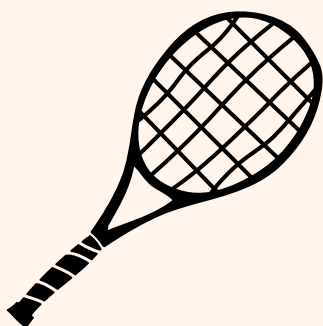
SPORTS CLUBS

The Autumn term line up runs until the end of December.



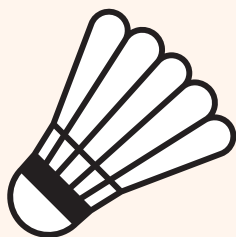

Friday Tennis



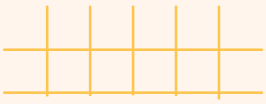
Clubs run from the end of school day and will finish at 4.15pm - children must be collected promptly at this time or will be at risk of being removed from the club.

They can answer any queries you may have, they are also there to support in setting up meetings with other members of staff here at High Street.

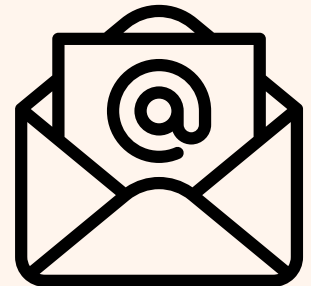
